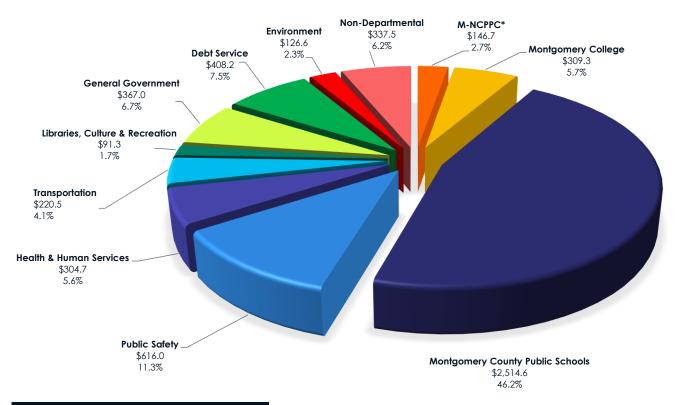

TOTAL EXPENDITURES - \$5,442.4

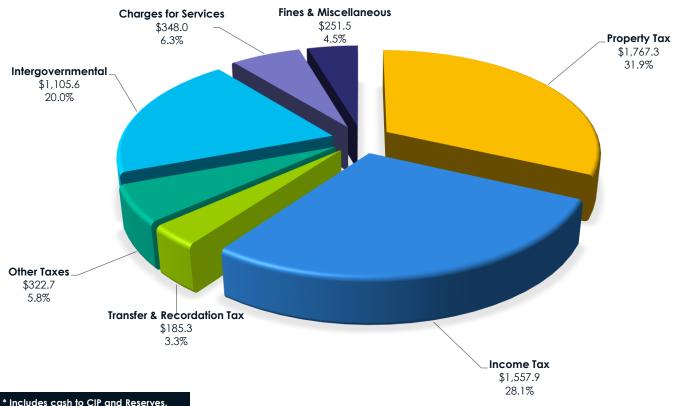

TOTAL Revenues - \$5,538.2

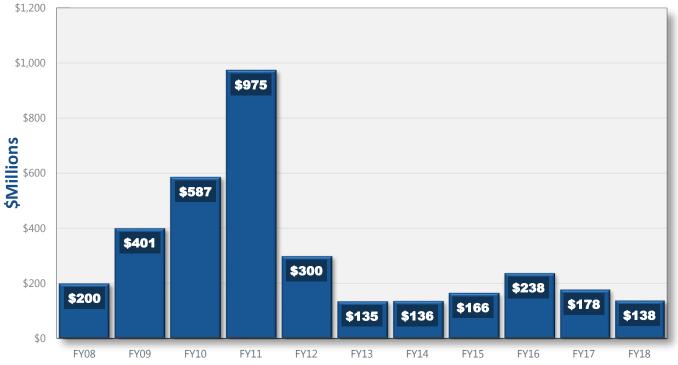

Actions taken to Close the Gap

Withheld steps and general wage adjustments

Required increased employee contributions to retirement and health benefit plans



Maintained MCPS at Maintenance of Effort (MOE) level or below for six years



Reduced the number of employees by over 1000 (or 10%) and maintained a lower per capita employee ratio (still below the FY 06 level)



Slowed the rate of growth in expenditures from double digit annual percentage growth prior to FY 08, to an average of 2.7 percent over the last 10 years.

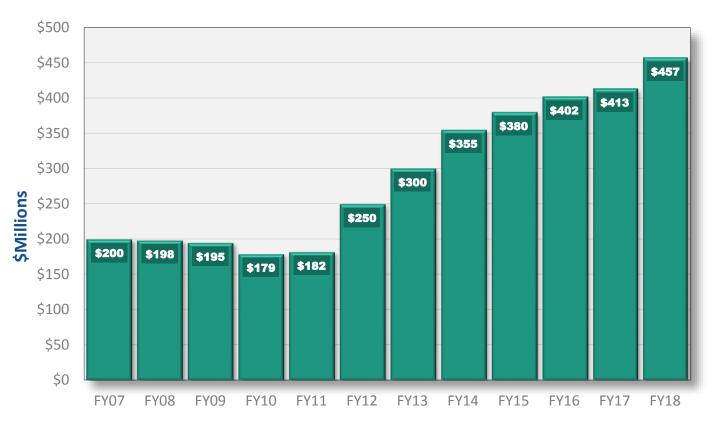

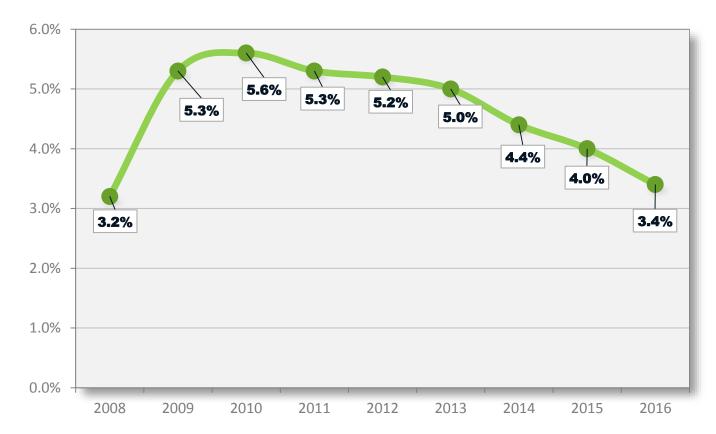

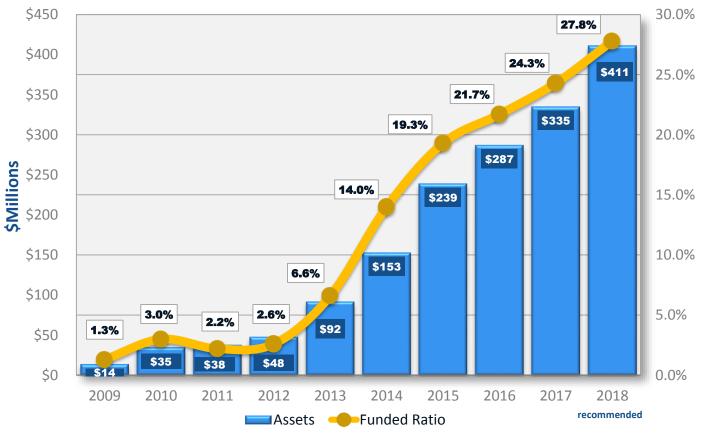
Reserves By Year
