(a) The board shall may publish a request 1.6 for proposal for participants who meet the requirements of this subdivision and are interested 1.7 in acting as the central repository for the drug repository program. The board If the board 1.8 publishes a request for proposal, it shall follow all applicable state procurement procedures 1.9 in the selection process. The board may also work directly with the University of Minnesota 1.10 to establish a central repository. 1.11

- (b) To be eligible to act as the central repository, the participant must be a wholesale 1.12
- drug distributor located in Minnesota, licensed pursuant to section 151.47, and in compliance 1.13 with all applicable federal and state statutes, rules, and regulations. 1.14
- (c) The central repository shall be subject to inspection by the board pursuant to section 1.15 151.06, subdivision 1. 1.16
- (d) The central repository shall comply with all applicable federal and state laws, rules, 1.17
- and regulations pertaining to the drug repository program, drug storage, and dispensing. 1.18
- The facility must maintain in good standing any state license or registration that applies to 1.19
- the facility." 1.20
